A. CALL TO ORDER

- G. GENERAL MANAGER REPORT:

James notified the Board about a main break that occurred today and was followed by a service line break. He also announced that the E.A.R. report has been completed and submitted to the State. James gave an update on the DWR grant stating that it may be necessary to file for an extension. He would like to be able to use that funding for the Plant B improvements, but the grant probably won't be finalized in time. The SRF grant is still open and may work for Plant B funding instead. Clearlake Oaks Water has 9 potable water tanks they're willing to sell us for \$4,000 each which is a substantial savings from purchasing new. The tanks could help get us through the Plant B repairs. Brelje & Race Engineers are requiring a \$5,000 retainer to begin the project. We will have to evaluate finances and may consider pulling from reserves. The General Managers Report was accepted on a motion by Director Barnhart, seconded by Director McElwain, with 4 ayes, 0 nays.

- Consideration of Salary Increase for Clerk of the Board: As a result of Amy's employee evaluation
 at the last Regular Meeting, Director Barnhart moved to increase her hourly wage by two dollars per
 hour effective July 1, 2022. This motion was seconded by Chair Haas. This motion passed with 4 ayes,
 0 nays.
- 2. Consideration to Resolve Error, Policy 2110: Health and Welfare Benefits: Amy wanted to explain an oversight on her part regarding sections 2110.1.2.1 and 2110.1.2.2 of the Health and Welfare Benefits Policy. According to the policy the health insurance "pool" should have been cancelled in February with the resignation of Joel Reim. She suggested the Board may want to consider revising the policy in the future. Regarding the current oversight, she asked the Board how
